

Instruction Manual



1. Open the frame by pulling the hinges outwards, with the adjustable feet towards you.



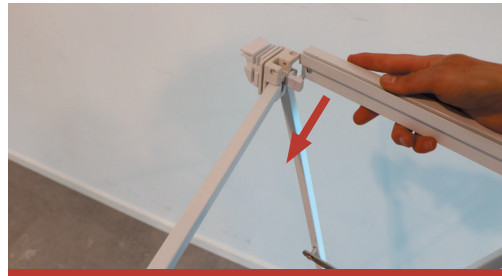
2. Place your hands on the crosses as shown in the picture.



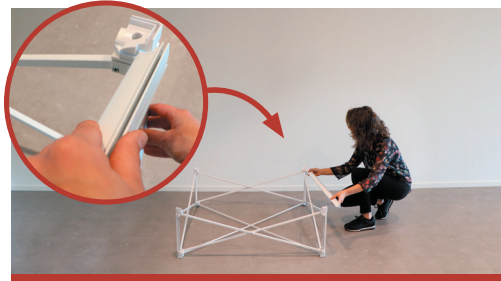
3. Gently lift up the frame while flipping it over, the frame will unfold itself.



4. Close the two clips to lock the frame.

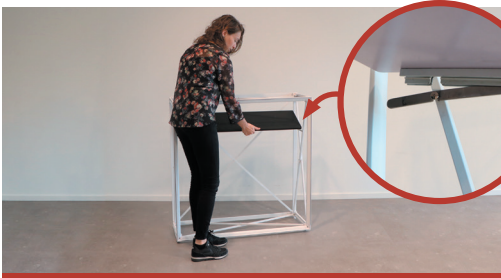


5. Close the attached bars in the four corners.



6. Place the frame on the ground and slide in the aluminium bars from the side.

Optional: See backside for placement **block-out fabric** and **LED curtains**



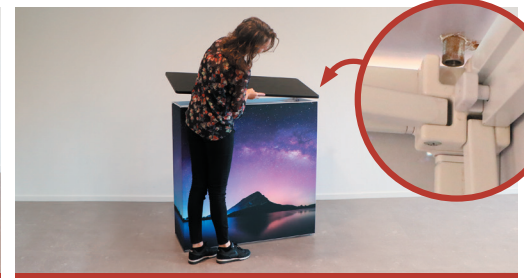
7. Place the shelf on top of the two aluminium clips, so the notch on the bottom of the shelf fits the screws.



8. Attach the print by pushing the silicone edges in the grooves.



9. Start in the corners, and work your way around the frame until all silicone edges are attached.



10. Place the tabletop on top of the frame, so the aluminium buttons fit the gaps in the frame.

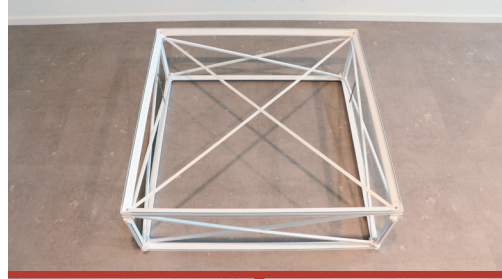


11. Your counter is now ready to use and can hold up to 55 kg.

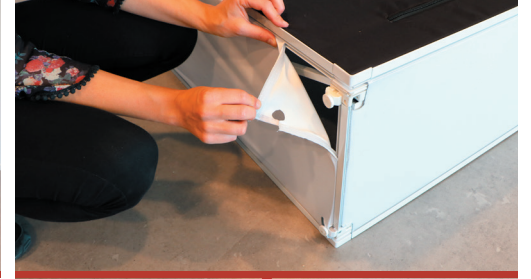
Optional:
Block-out fabric
and Led curtains



7. Place the frame on the ground with the backside (textile cross) facing up.



8. Attach the black fabric by pushing the silicone edges in the grooves.



9. Place the block-out fabric on both sides and the bottom of the frame.



10. Place the shelf on top of the two aluminium clips, so the notch on the bottom of the shelf fits the screws.



11. Place the LED curtains on the frontside of the frame.



12. Attach the LED curtains by connecting the four clips to the crosses of the frame.



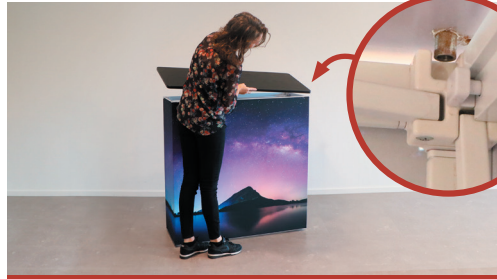
13. Connect the adapter to the LED curtain plug on the bottom side.



14. You can leave the adapter inside the counter, and open a small gap in the block-out to let the cable come out



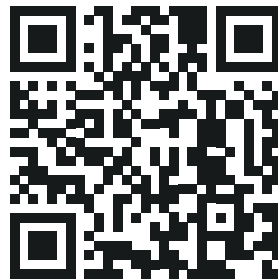
15. Attach the print on the frontside. Use the outer groove on the sides to cover the block-out fabric.



16. Place the tabletop on top of the frame, so the aluminium buttons fit the gaps in the frame.



17. Your counter is now ready to use and can hold up to 55 kg.
